<u>CLUBS</u> – Please see clubs list attached. Children who would like to attend clubs will need to sign up for the whole half term. The clubs we offer are planned units with built in progression of skills and cannot be joined once started.

AFTERSCHOOL PLAY CLUB - If you need childcare after school and your child is not signed up to an afterschool club or they are not interested in the clubs on offer then they can attend our after school play club, this needs to be booked 1 week in advance at the cost of £2 per hour to cover staff costs. If you should require last minute child care you will be charged accordingly but you will need to contact the office as soon as possible to ensure we can accommodate your child on that day. Parents who are in receipt of Free School Meals (not Universal Free School Meals) may be eligible for a discount on request. If you are interested in using the after school care please return the attached form to the office by Monday 10th September.

CROSSCOUNTRY RACE – The first race of the season is on Tuesday, 11th September at Porthleven School and we will leave here at 3.30pm and will be back at school by 5.00pm. The children who are signed up to the club and are in Yr3-Yr6 will be taking part in Tuesdays crosscountry race. There will be 6 races over the whole season and any child that takes part in at least 5 will receive an Endurance Medal at the end of the season. Crosscountry club is open to the whole school and therefore if any child, that is younger than Yr3 that is signed up for club, would like to come along with us to the races to help us cheer our runners on, they are more than welcome.
