Wraparound Care (breakfast club and afterschool care) – available every day from 8.00am – 9.00am and 3.30pm–4.30pm. Please contact Mrs Care in the office to book your child/ren in. We do ask for 24 hours notice of any cancellation and also that they are picked up promptly, in order for you not to incur a charge.

St Germoe PCC recognises the likely problems that people will face over the winter months and in an effort to provide help and support has decided that the Church Hall will be open to anyone between the hours of 9am until 4pm Monday to Friday starting in November. Packet and tinned foods will be available and also the option for people to cook their own food. The Hall will be heated and it is hoped that full use will be made of the facilities.
