HELP US REINSTATE THE SCHOOL CROSSING PATROL!!!!!!. The week beginning 7th October (date to be confirmed), Cornwall Council will carry out a survey of children walking to school and having to cross the main road. If there are 14 or more children needing to cross then they will reinstate the school crossing patrol. This will then help us to organise a walking bus to school every morning from the community centre. There would be so many benefits to this such as healthier children, less congestion in the car park. Please could you park up on or near the community centre on this day around 0845 and walk your child to school from there. A member of staff will be down there to help. Please be respectful of other people when you are parking at school and please do not park on the pavements or the yellow zig zags outside of the school as this is a serious hazard for pedestrians some of which are Germoe children who walk to and from school each day, parents with pushchairs and also residents in the village who all have to walk out into the road to get past. We do understand that our car park is small but we are very lucky to have one at all.

FREE SCHOOL MEALS – All children who are in Reception, Yr 1 or Yr2, even though they are entitled to Universal Free School Meals, may also still be entitled to Free School Meals, which may entitle them to trip subsidies.

The criteria to get FSM is:

- Income Support
- Income based Job Seekers Allowance
- Income related Employ & Support Allowance
- Child Tax Credit
- State Pension Credit
