HELP US REINSTATE THE SCHOOL CROSSING PATROL!!!!!!. We are still waiting to hear when Cornwall Council will be coming to carry out a survey of children walking to school and having to cross the main road. They won't come if the weather is bad as not enough people will use it that day so they will try to come on a day when the weather is dry. If there are 14 or more children needing to cross then they will reinstate the school crossing patrol. This will then help us to organise a walking bus to school every morning from the community centre. There would be so many benefits to this such as healthier children, less congestion in the car park. Please could you park up on or near the community centre on this day around 0845 and walk your child to school from there. A member of staff will be down there to help. Please be respectful of other people when you are parking at school and **please do not park on the pavements or the yellow zig zags** outside of the school as this is a serious hazard for pedestrians some of which are Germoe children who walk to and from school each day, parents with pushchairs and also residents in the village who all have to walk out into the road to get past. We do understand that our car park is small but we are very lucky to have one at all.

RECYCLING BINS Please do not put your general waste eg water bottles, named envelopes or MacDonald's wrappers in the recycling bins by the car park as our FROGS members are having to remove all unwanted items which is not a very pleasant task!!
