**UNIFORM** Thank you all so much for being patient! It has been stressful for all involved but it has been out of our hands. We have recently had a delivery but unfortunately, the printers have printed the wrong logo on the sweatshirts. Instead of the individual school name in a Superman style logo which was chosen by our pupils, they have printed our federation name, Team BG which we use on staff and leavers hoodies and our trips and competitions. On the plus side, they are the right colour and style, also chosen by vote by our children. **TOOT TOOT** is an electronic platform that we are using as part of our well-being and safeguarding tool kit in school. Children in Y2 - Y6 will be given a personal log in and password so that they can log in to report things that are worrying them. Teachers will then be sent a notification and will be able to help immediately. Children are still likely to speak face to face with a trusted adult first, but this gives the opportunity to share concerns in a different way. The more tools our children have, the safer they will be.

#### **POINTS OF CONTACT**
