CHRISTMAS PRODUCTION We would all like to say a massive thank you FROGS for organising the refreshments and raffle on Monday. They raised in total £186-80 which will go towards our fundraising for the toilet refurbishment. Also a really big well done to all the children and to the staff for a wonderful performance

SWIMMING will recommence in the spring term (January 10th) on Wednesday mornings. Please note children will be required to be in school by 8.25 am **at the latest** as we will be leaving school by coach at 8.30am so that children can be changed and at poolside by 9.00 am. Unfortunately, due to budget cuts and increased travel expenses, we have had to increase the cost of swimming to £3.50 a week next term. There will be 10 sessions for years 1-6. You can either pay £35 at the beginning of term or £3.50 a week for 10 weeks. We feel it is really important for children to learn how to swim well considering our locality and although we appreciate that it does cost money, the swimming will no longer be sustainable for the whole school if we don't get enough parent contributions in. If you need any help with payments, please call into the office and we can discuss a payment plan.
